## Our Mission

The Singapore Funds Industry Group (“**SFIG**”) is a unique public-private partnership between the Monetary Authority of Singapore and key Singapore asset management industry stakeholders, enhancing Singapore’s value proposition as an asset management and funds domiciliation hub.

SFIG brings together all the key players across the entire asset management value chain, including fund managers, service providers such as lawyers, tax advisors, fund administrators, and fund directors. SFIG identifies emerging industry trends and formulates strategies to further enhance Singapore’s flourishing asset management ecosystem.

## Strong Public-Private Partnership in Singapore's Asset Management Ecosystem

SFIG demonstrates a strong public-private partnership where the asset management industry and the regulator come together to drive cross-sectoral initiatives and provide opportunities to allow:

1. Collaboration across industry sub-sectors working towards common developmental goals
2. Cross fertilization of ideas across fund value chains and work streams
3. Bottom-up initiatives and co-ownership of project outcomes with industry
4. Scalability of industry-wide projects & stakeholders buy-in

## Constituent Working Groups (WGs)

(i) The Infrastructure and Innovation WG monitors market developments and spurs innovation to transform the fund servicing value chain.

(ii) The Policy WG provides advice and recommends improvements to regulatory, legal and tax frameworks, to better serve the needs of fund managers and investors.

(iii) The Capabilities and Training WG focuses on building a deep pool of fund specialists and directors in areas such as product development, administration, distribution and fund oversight and governance.

(iv) The Promotion and Advocacy WG raises the global profile of Singapore as a leading asset management and fund domiciliation hub, through outreach and engagements with Singapore-based and global asset managers, asset owners and service providers.
